Applicants should live or work in Whitley County. Applicants should have the full support of the organization or business they represent. Participants are expected to attend at least 80 percent of the sessions from October through March and participate on a community action team. Absences or lack of participation may result in termination from the class or participant may be asked to make up absences the following year. Attendance at orientation, retreat and celebration are *mandatory*.

Application must be signed by candidate AND employer. The early bird application deadline is **May 30**. The deadline for all applications is **June 30**. Notification of acceptance into the program is **August 1**.
