Applicants should live or work in Whitley County. Applicants should have the full support of the organization or business they represent. Participants are expected to attend at least 80 percent of the sessions from October through March. Absences or lack of participation may result in termination from the class or participant may be asked to make up absences the following year. Attendance at orientation on Thursday, September 5, 2019 at 6:00 PM, the retreat on Thursday, September 19, 2019 at 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM and Friday, September 20, 2019 at 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM and the celebration on Thursday, April 16, 2020 at 6:00 PM are **mandatory**.

Application must be signed by candidate AND employer. The early bird application deadline is **May 31, 2019**. The deadline for all applications is **June 28, 2019**. Notification of acceptance into the program is by **August 1, 2019**.
